Position

This is a field services role associated with environmental air monitoring systems known as Continuous Emissions Monitoring Systems (CEMS). Responsibilities will be various tasks to the betterment of this division and will include but not limited to visits to associated sites, repair of analyzers, preparation of reports, phone support of operating systems, general electronics repair, panel fabrication, general plumbing and electrical work, and clerical duties as apply.

Responsibilities:

- General CEMS Services to include preventative maintenance duties, wiring & plumbing, ability to climb and lift heavy objects and work at elevated heights, produce service reports, and adhere to ATI and customer site safety standards.
- Maintains proper data file repositories, such as backup for contracted sites to prevent data loss.
- Communicates effectively with coworkers and site personnel.
- Communicates with field personnel for reporting related documents.
- Communication with customers of actions (remote or onsite work).
- Produces Compliance Reports by acquiring necessary data from site. Reports to be proofread for errors, omissions and/or validation. Report documents are to be filed in an orderly fashion.
- Produces regular reports from DAS systems
- Acquires necessary CGA, Linearity, Certification reports.
- Maintains phone support & available to supported sites during assigned hours.
- General electronic, and analyzer repair
 - Able to troubleshoot problems and develop solutions
 - Able to understand complication of interdependent systems
 - Create digital file for work and historical reference
 - Maintains IT systems for maximum uptime
- Clerical work including spreadsheets, Quotes and Knowledgebase documents
- Assist in field work including but not limited to: Site installs & Repair or retrofit of systems
- Other Tasks as required
